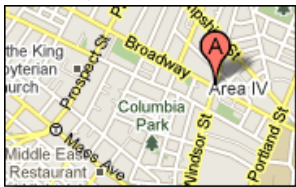

n They Killed Him at 10:18, the plane is disabled, 7 miles from the airport. The King Air A-100 turbo prop flies treetop level over shocked witnesses, 5 miles out: no lights, crabbed cockeyed, engines spooling down, so low witnesses are amazed it stays airborne. Three more miles and the plane stalls, dropping into the woods, killing all 8 on board.
