- John Pilger looks at world-wide propaganda surrounding the nuclear arms race. "By using reassuring, even soothing language, this new kind of propaganda created acceptable images of war and the illusion that we could live securely with nuclear weapons".
 - This film examines official 'truths' in connection with the bombing of Hiroshima, the build-up of arms by Russia and America, the siting of nuclear bases by the US in Britain and Europe, the \$\$\$ of government money spent on weapons ... a NATO 'limited' nuclear and chemical war exercise in West Germany, which Pilger describes as 'a dry run for the unthinkable'.
